**Quarterly Report 2026/1**  
**by the Board of the Register of Damage**  
**Caused by the Aggression of the Russian Federation against Ukraine**  
**to the Conference of Participants**

**Introduction**

1. The Board of the Register of Damage Caused by the Aggression of the Russian Federation against Ukraine (“the Board” and “the Register” respectively) held its 10th meeting online on 2 February and 1 April 2026.
2. On the agenda were updates from the Executive Director on the work of the Register, including in relation to forthcoming category launches; a discussion of the consequences of the humanitarian crisis caused by strikes on energy and infrastructure, as well as the legal qualification of these events and the Register’s communication on these issues; an update on the establishment of the International Claims Commission for Ukraine; and the Board’s assessment and decisions on recommendations presented by the Executive Director on the eligibility of claims for recording in the Register in categories A1.1, A2.1, A2.3, A3.1, and A3.3.

**Decisions on eligibility of claims for recording in the Register**

3. On the basis of the recommendation by the Executive Director and the Board’s assessment, the Board decided to adopt:
  - Two decisions (RD4U-Board-CLD(2026)05 and RD4U-Board-CLD(2026)06) recording 7,744 claims in category A1.1 in the Register;
  - Three decisions (RD4U-Board-CLD(2026)02, RD4U-Board-CLD(2026)03, and RD4U-Board-CLD(2026)04) recording 1,343 claims in category A2.1 in the Register;
  - Three decisions (RD4U-Board-CLD(2026)07, RD4U-Board-CLD(2026)08, and RD4U-Board-CLD(2026)09) recording 135 claims in category A2.3 in the Register;
  - One decision (RD4U-Board-CLD(2026)01) recording 1,026 claims in category A3.1 in the Register; and
  - One decision (RD4U-Board-CLD(2026)10) recording 387 claims in category A3.3 in the Register.

**Report under Article 6.9 of the Statute**

4. Under Article 6.9 of the Statute, the Board is to provide quarterly reports to the Conference of Participants. Such reports shall include the number of claims received

and the number of eligible claims recorded in the Register, the relevant categories and the total amount of compensation sought (if applicable). Such reports shall also include the summary of other significant factual or legal matters relevant to the work of the Register.
